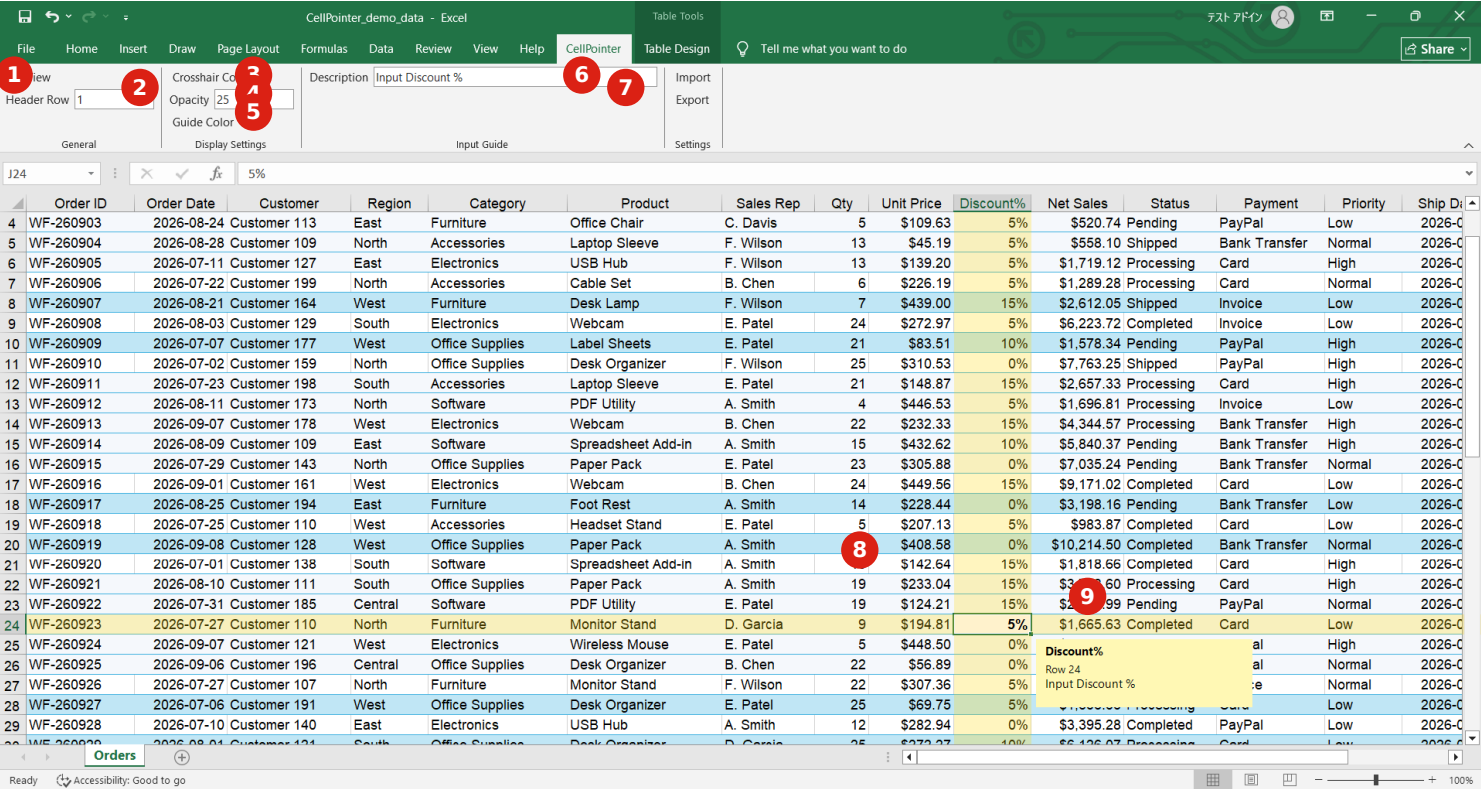


CellPointer Quick Start Guide



1

View

Turn the CellPointer view on or off.

2

Header Row

Specify the row that contains the field names (column headings).

3

Crosshair Color

Choose the color of the crosshair that highlights the active row and column.

4

Opacity

Adjust the transparency of the crosshair.

5

Guide Color

Choose the color of the input guide (the column highlight).

6

Description

Set the text that appears as the field description for the selected cell.

7

Import / Export

Save your settings or load a previously saved configuration.

8

Crosshair

Highlights the active row and column so you can easily see where you are.

9

Input Guide

Displays the column name, row number and field description next to the active cell.

Getting Started

1. Install CellPointer using CellPointerSetup.exe.
2. Open Microsoft Excel and select the CellPointer tab.
3. Turn on View and specify the Header Row.
4. Select a cell. CellPointer follows it as you move through the worksheet.

Windows SmartScreen

CellPointer is currently distributed without a commercial code-signing certificate. If Microsoft Defender SmartScreen appears, select 'More info' and then 'Run anyway' to continue the installation.
